Subject: Personally Owned Vehicles / Pedestrian Traffic Delays

Please be advised that the San Luis I Port of Entry Modernization and Expansion Project is now underway. This is great and welcomed opportunity for our community, but as the project advances, challenges will arise, and travel delays should be and need to be expected. The Port of San Luis is working diligently to minimize impact to the traveling public and asks that travelers, port users, and stakeholders remain patient and plan accordingly for potentially elevated wait times and increased traffic.

Public Progress Update: 07/28/2023

Starting Monday July 31, 2023, all northbound traffic will exit the port of entry at Urtuzuastegui Street and Main Steet. Due to construction, the exit at Urtuzuastegui Street and William Brooks Avenue will no longer be available. There may be temporary delays for inbound traffic (Mexico to the U.S.) as traffic filters out of the port of entry and into the city of San Luis, AZ.
