WHEREAS, the City of San Luis desires to join the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement (dated February 23, 2026)

WHEREAS, participants in the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement must opt-in before May 4, 2026.

WHEREAS, the San Luis City Council finds it in the public interest for the City to join the settlement for the benefits provided from the abatement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:


SECTION 1: The above-recited understanding and findings of the San Luis City Council are incorporated by this reference and made a part of this order.
