A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FY 2026 STATE SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS (CDBG-SSP), CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona, is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the state SSP Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressionally mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within these applications address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low-and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, an Applicant for State CDBG-SSP funds are required to comply with the program guidelines and federal statutes and regulations

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma, authorize this application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2026 CDBG – SSP (State Special Projects) funds, and authorize the Mayor to sign the application, contract or grant documents for receipt of use of these funds for Rancho Los Oros Phase III, and authorize the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said applications; and

THAT, this application for State CDBG funds meets the requirement of low-and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefiting low-and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

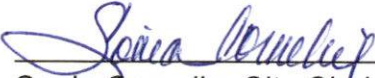
