A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF RIGHT OF WAY ON AVENUE F FROM COUNTY 23RD STREET TO COUNTY 23 ½ STREET AND COUNTY 23RD STREET FROM AVENUE F TO AVENUE F ¼ FROM YUMA COUNTY

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Yuma County, Arizona and City of San Luis are authorized to approve transfers of adjacent County rights of ways pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-471(O); and

WHEREAS, On June 1, 2026 The Board of Supervisors of Yuma County, Arizona approved Resolution No. 2026-23 transferring County rights of ways to the City of San Luis; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis have determined it is in the best interest of the City to accept said rights of ways.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

Section 1: The Mayor and City Council, by this resolution, approve the transfer of right of way on Avenue F from County 23rd Street to County 23 ½ Street and County 23rd Street from Avenue F to Avenue F ¼ from Yuma County to the City of San Luis.

Section 2: The transfer of the rights of ways shall be treated by the City of San Luis as if the transferred right of way was newly annexed territory, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-471(O).

Section 3: The City Council authorizes and directs the appropriate City Officers and employees to perform all necessary or desirable acts to give effect to this Resolution.

Section 4: If a conflict arises between this resolution and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are amended, superseded, and replaced, and this resolution shall govern.

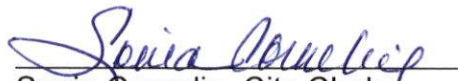
Section 5: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause phrase, or a portion of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of

competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this resolution.

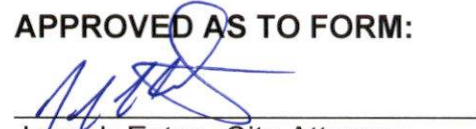

TRANSFERRING THE RIGHT OF WAY ON AVENUE F FROM
COUNTY 23RD STREET TO COUNTY 23 ½ STREET AND
COUNTY 23RD STREET FROM AVENUE F TO AVENUE F ¼ TO
THE CITY OF SAN LUIS

- WHEREAS: The Board of Supervisors of Yuma County, Arizona has the authority under Title 9 of the Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.), more specifically, Section 9-471 (O), to transfer county rights of ways to adjacent municipalities, and
- WHEREAS: The City of San Luis has requested from Yuma County to transfer the right of ways and allow the City to take ownership of said roadways within the identified limits, and
- WHEREAS: The City of San Luis, through resolution, has agreed to take over these rights of ways, and
- WHEREAS: The transfer will allow the City of Yuma to develop this portion of Avenue F and County 23rd Street to City of San Luis standards and specifications, and
- WHEREAS: The Board of Supervisors of Yuma County, Arizona has determined that it is in the best interest of Yuma County and City of San Luis to transfer said right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the right of way along Avenue F between County 23rd Street and County 23 ½ Street and the right of way along County 23rd Street between Avenue F and Avenue F ¼ be transferred to the City of San Luis as follows:

SECTION 1. The transfer of the rights of ways shall be treated by the City of San Luis as if the transferred right of way was a newly annexed territory.

SECTION 2. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflicts.

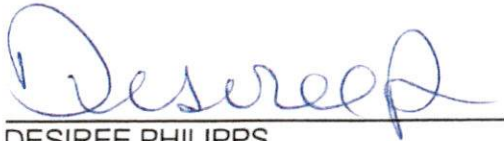
SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect when the City of San Luis adopts their resolution accepting said right of way.

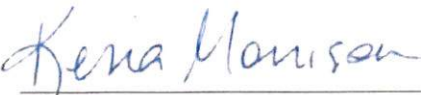
