A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS AS LEVERAGE FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT STATE SPECIAL PROJECT APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona has adopted Resolution No. 2399 which authorizes submission of an application to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for Community Development Block Grant State Special Projects (CDBG-SSP) funds for the Federal Fiscal Year 2025- 2026; and

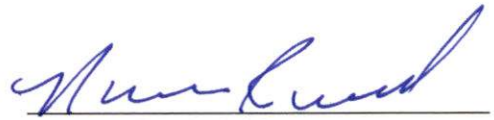
WHEREAS, that application indicates that \$235,488.00 will be committed by the City of San Luis as leveraged funds, in the form of cash to be used to implement activity #2 Rancho Los Oros Roadway Improvements Phase III; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Program requires that all local leveraged funds be committed in the form of a resolution by the governing body, and that such a commitment contains an opinion by the applicant's legal counsel that the leveraged funds represent a binding commitment, legally enforceable under State Laws,

WHEREAS, the Applicant for the State CDBG – SSP funds are required to comply with the program guidelines and federal statutes and regulations.

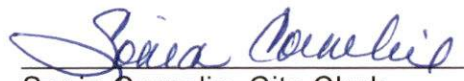
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma, commit leverage and commit \$235,488.00 to the CDBG – SSP Program, to be used for the Rancho Los Oros Roadway Improvements Phase III, for the construction efforts, contingent upon receipt of the FFY 2025 – FFY 2026 CDBG – SSP assistance; and that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma hereby state that this commitment is legally binding based on the legal opinion of the City of San Luis attorney, and that such funds will be available for an audit at the termination of the grant, if so required by ADOH.
